STATE FINANCIAL OFFICERS EXPRESS CONCERN ABOUT TESLA ATTACKS:

Baton Rouge, LA — Last week, Louisiana State Treasurer John Fleming, M.D., and 25 other state financial officers sent a letter to the U.S. Department of Justice, expressing deep concern over the coordinated and violent attacks on Tesla dealerships and vehicles nationwide. In the letter, Dr. Fleming and the State Financial Officers Foundation (SFOF) members emphasized the severe impact these attacks have on public safety, private property rights, and the financial security of millions of Americans. Dr. Fleming stressed that the growing wave of violence against Tesla has not only resulted in significant damage to private property but also had a direct financial impact on state pension funds, which support public school teachers, first responders, and police officers.

STATE TREASURER FLEMING AND SEN. RICK EDMONDS UNVEIL K-12 TRANSPARENCY PORTAL PROJECT :

Baton Rouge— On, Wednesday, April 2 at 10 a.m. Louisiana State Treasurer John Fleming, M.D., and Louisiana State Senator Rick Edmonds (R-BR) held a news conference to unveil the Louisiana K-12 School Transparency Website. The press conference took place at the Governor’s Press Room on the 4th Floor of the Louisiana State Capitol, 900 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge. During this news conference, State Treasurer Fleming and State Senator Edmonds shared important details about this new platform and its vital role in providing transparency for Louisiana’s K-12 schools. According to the enabling legislation, the project will give taxpayers “easy access to details regarding how public schools are spending public funds.” This vital information “increases transparency in public school financial matters and increases community and parent involvement.”
